It's a scientist who studies the evolution of climate change and the succession of weather conditions over long periods.

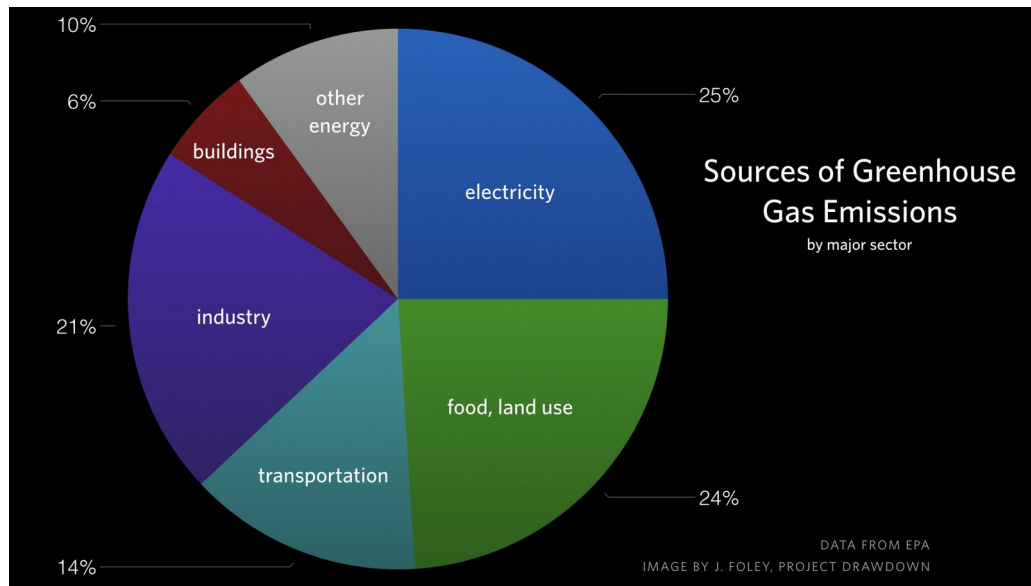

# Causes and consequences



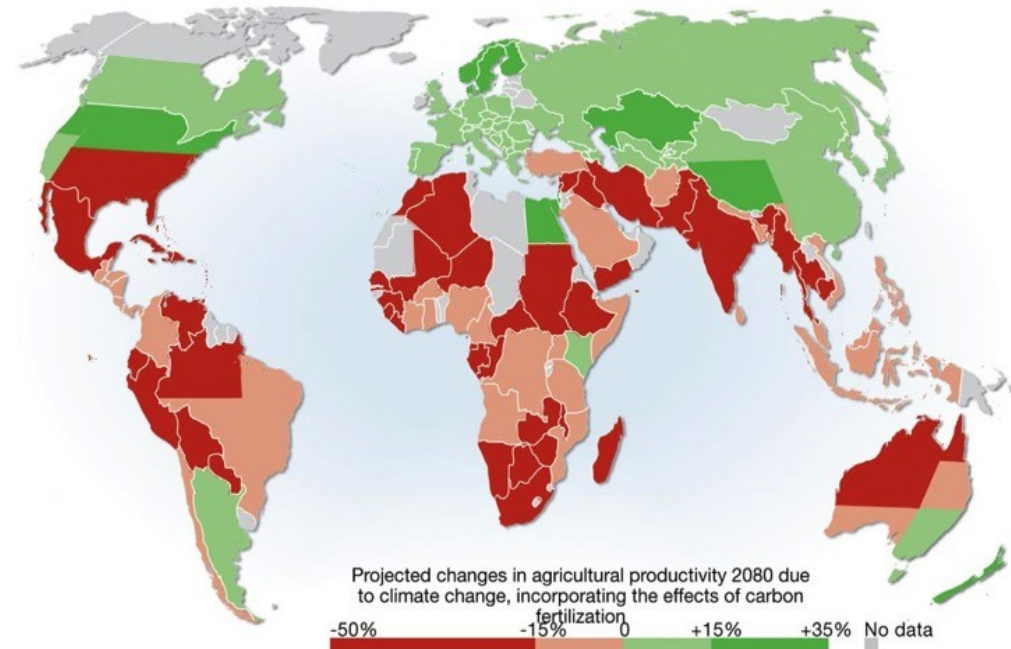
- They produce a lot of gases

Projected changes in agricultural productivity 2080 due to climate change, incorporating the effects of carbon fertilization (Ahlenius, 2009)





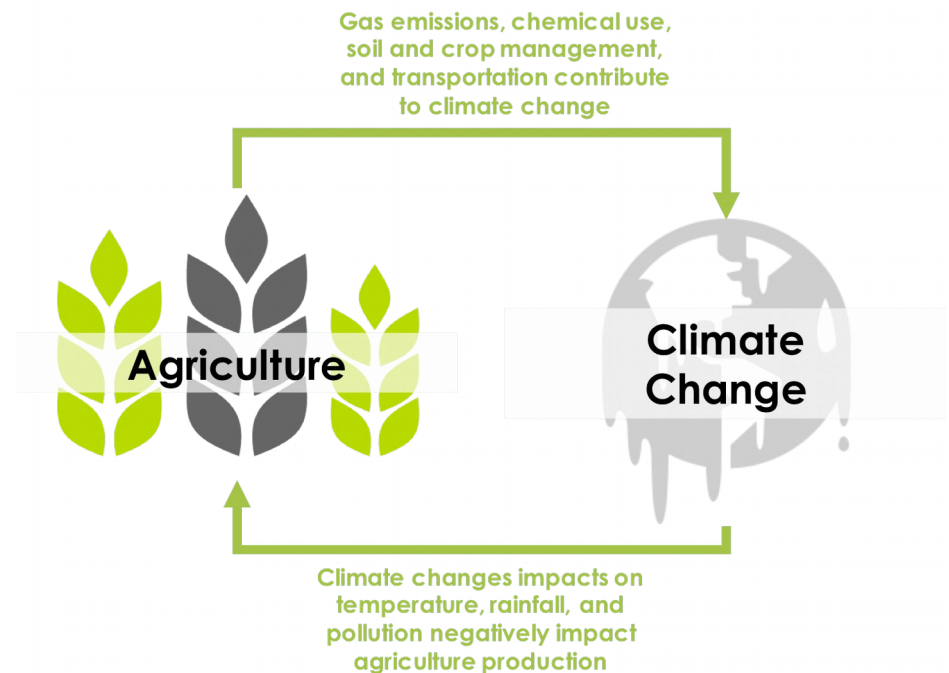
# Inverse causes and consequences
